

Thanks to all of you in the community who submitted ideas during our campaign to rename the library district! Fox River Valley Public Library District is the name chosen by the library's Board of Trustees. The name change will become official on July 1. In addition, the district's existing facility in East Dundee has officially been named the "Dundee Library" and the planned facility inside the Randall Oaks Recreation Center at 500 N. Randall Road will be known as the "Randall Oaks Branch Library."

"We were very pleased with the positive, thoughtful ideas we received from the community. As the entries came in, it became quite clear that residents strongly identify with the Fox River," said library director Roxane Bennett.





READING PATCH CLUB RETURNS IN AUGUST






