DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

As I was leaving the library last week, two young women with backpacks, books, and poster boards asked me if the library had a room where they could spread out and work on a school project together without disturbing anyone else. Sadly, I had to tell them "No, you'll have to take your chances finding an open table." Scenes like this happen every day.

Users need places to gather – rooms for group projects, tutoring sessions, study groups, video and in-person conferences, meetings, and programs. Other users need quiet, individual spaces in which to read or study.

Currently, the Dundee Library has a single large meeting room that is used for events of all kinds - storytimes, computer classes, movies, book discussions, board meetings, class visits, gaming programs, play groups, and programs for children, teens, and adults. A children's craft room that accommodates about 12 is also used for smaller adult programs.

Meanwhile, the Randall Oaks Library has no meeting room at all. The entire library is disrupted four to five times a week while up to 60 people squeeze into a storytime or other program.

Joe Huberty, the architect engaged by the library board, developed concept sketches for an updated Dundee Library which includes a meeting room, storytime room, maker lab, computer lab and seven study rooms. Preliminary plans for a new library building to replace the Randall Oaks Library include two meeting rooms, two storytime rooms, a conference room, maker lab, computer classroom, and 18 study rooms for individuals or small groups.

We'll be looking for your feedback at our next Designing Our Future session when the architect will share his concept sketches for a new library west of the river. 
