September is Library Card Sign-up Month, a time when the Fox River Valley Public Library District joins with the American Library Association and public libraries nationwide to make sure that our students have the most important school supply of all – a free library card.

Resources at the Dundee Library and Randall Oaks Branch Library are available to anyone who has a library card. Students can turn to the library for materials, programs and services that support academic achievement.

Students (and all cardholders!) have access to books, magazines, videos, music, audiobooks, and games that encompass the collections of 25 additional area libraries. Students who are working on a special project, need access to a computer, scanner, or printer, or just need a quiet place to work will find it at the library.

There are many fun and educational programs for younger students that will expose them to great literature, faraway places, and new skills. Our older students can benefit from our free computer classes and fun groups when they need to take a break, like TAG or Anime Club.

The benefits of a library card can be experienced right from home as well. Through our website we provide a portal to information that includes ebooks and audiobooks, research databases, and free downloadable music. There are also a wide variety of links to help students find quality information online.

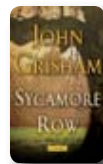

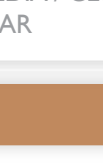

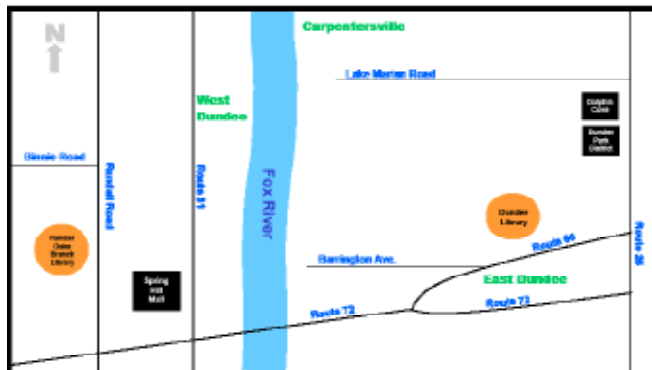
