



"PAWS TO READ" SUMMER READING CLUB STARTS JUNE 2

Summertime is a chance to read outdoors and stay up late finishing just one more chapter for children who love reading. But for other children, an entire summer without reading can mean a loss of two months to a year of reading achievement. All the hard work and reading success accomplished during nine months of school can be wiped out during the summer. Those losses add up each year – at the end of sixth grade, a child could be two full years behind his grade level if he doesn't read during the summer.

We're here to help keep your child's reading skills on track. Our summer reading clubs are a casual, fun way to keep your child reading. For eight weeks, June 2 – July 26, children read and earn tickets for grand prize drawings. Children set their own reading goals and keep track of their progress. Along the way, there are prizes, games, programs, and entertainers to keep them engaged. While kids are having fun in our Paws to Read summer reading club, they're actually maintaining their reading levels so they can go back to school in the fall ready to pick up where they left off. Give your child tools for success. Encourage reading with trips to the library, by keeping books and reading materials in the house, and by combining books with other activities. If you're planning a trip to the zoo or the beach, why not read a book about it, too? Set aside time for reading, let your children read what they want, and talk with them about what they're reading. Show your child that you, too, enjoy reading. Why not sign up for the adult summer reading program? There's a \$100 gift card for the grand prize drawing and a chance to show your child that reading is fun.

If you need suggestions about books that your child might enjoy, or books that you can read to your child, please ask our staff. They are the experts and can guide you and your children to books that will ignite their imaginations, satisfy their curiosity, and nourish a lifetime love of reading.



And don't think we've forgotten the teenagers! For teens, we have a summer reading club that also offers weekly gift card drawings and a book prize at the end.

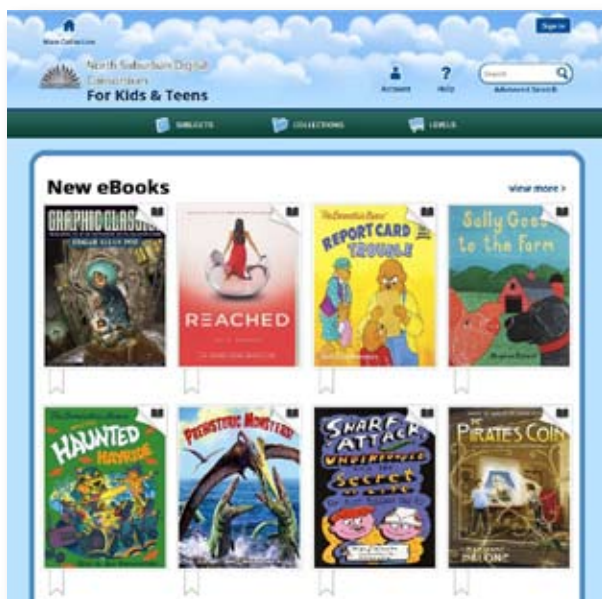

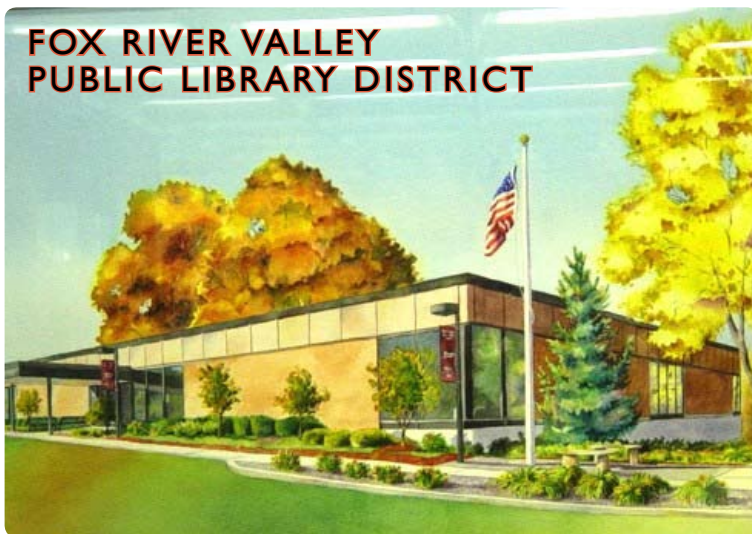
