DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

Residents applauded architect Joe Huberty's presentation on concepts for an environmentally friendly new library building on the west side of the river.

On February 9, Huberty presented the third Designing *Our Future* session highlighting features such as a vibrant children's services area, an adaptable design for changing technology needs, comfortable browsing and

reading areas, and a section of the building to be available for after-hours use, providing a muchneeded community center for the area.

The Randall Oaks Library is currently in a 5,000-square-foot space rented from the park district. The rented facility is a temporary solution to an urgent, ongoing problem - providing adequate library services to a growing district of 70,000 people spread over 40 square miles. The district's service area is roughly from Powers Road on the west to Cook County on the east and from Big Timber on the south to County Line Road on the north. Studies forecast that future growth in the area will shift the majority of the district's population west of the river.

"I'm excited about the prospect of the library as a community center," said Mary Kay Botkins of East Dundee.

In the first two Designing Our Future sessions, Huberty described possible renovations to the Dundee Library to incorporate space previously occupied by Dundee Township and adding a small expansion to house a drive up book return window. Professional library consultants agree that a new library building near the current Randall Oaks Library, along with renovations to the Dundee Library, would balance services for the entire district. Most importantly, nearly half of the respondents to a 2015 survey indicated that a new library building near the current location would be ideal.

Public meetings and surveys are shaping these plans. A survey posted on the library's website (www.frvpld.info) until March 7 is another opportunity for our community to have input. Please take a minute to fill out the survey - we want to hear from you.
