



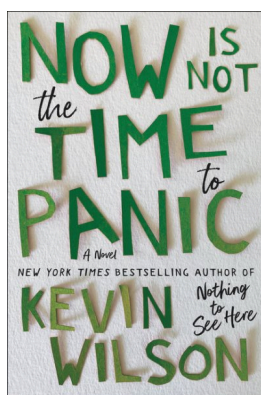

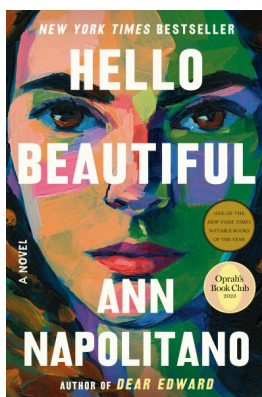

by Kevin Wilson

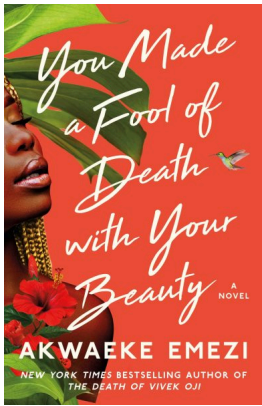

by Ann Napolitano

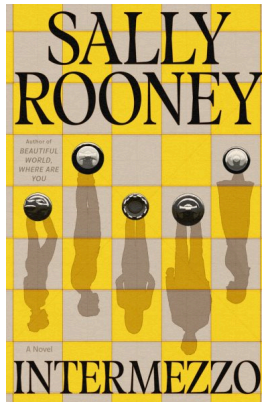

by Akwaeke Emezi

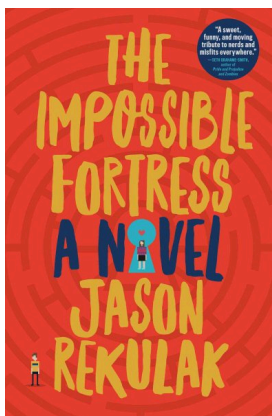

by Sally Rooney

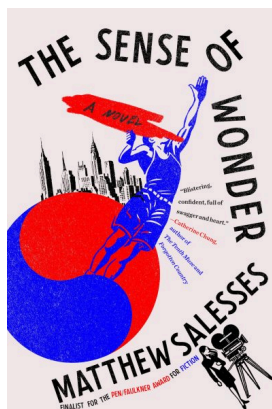

by Jason Rekulak

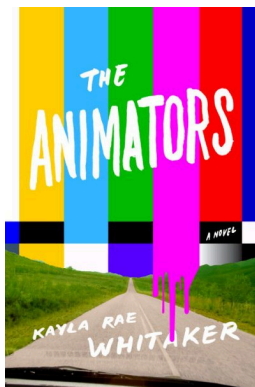

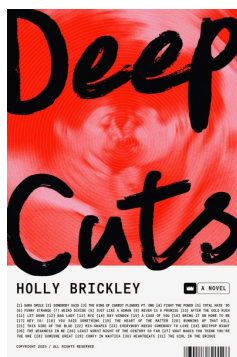


The animators : a novel

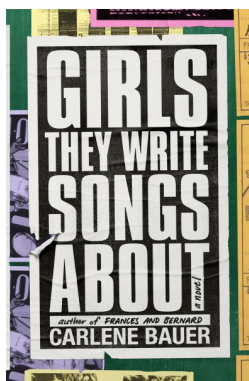

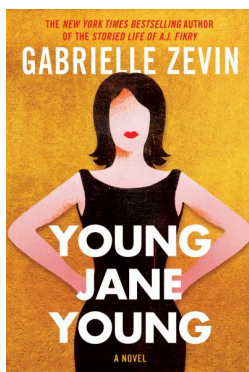


Girls they write songs about

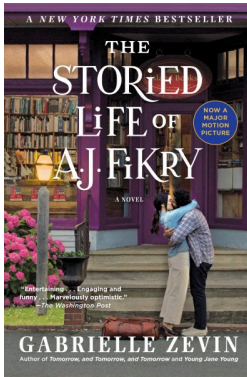

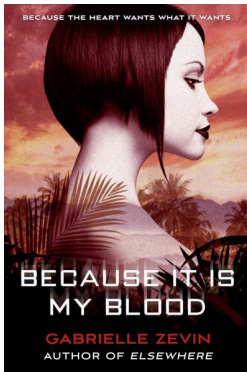
