

# Mini BOOKSHELF

Make a miniature bookshelf complete with to-scale versions of your favorite titles.

## Included in this kit

- Metal tin
- Popsicle sticks (\*5): 2 long, 3 short
- Adhesive (\*2): mod podge, super glue
- Brushes (\*2): paint brush, foam brush
- Scrap book paper
- Foam strips (\*2)
- Mini book covers
- Misc. odds & ends

## You Will Need

- Scissors
- Additional odds & ends (Optional)





# INSTRUCTIONS

## Step #1: Put Up Wallpaper

Trace the bottom of your tin onto the scrap book paper TWICE, then cut out both shapes. Use mod podge to glue paper to the inside of the lid & body of the tin. Let dry.

## Step #2: Install Shelves

Attach popsicle stick to the inside of tin with super glue to create shelving. Included supplies allow for a simple unit -two long shelves- or the ladder unit shown on the right.



## Step #3: Acquire Books

Cut out mini book cover then remove paper from foam rectangle. Align and press on front cover. Wrap the cover around the foam until the back of the book is aligned and press until secured.

Note: Use template linked on program event page to create book covers of your favorite titles.

## Step #4: Fill Shelves & Decorate

Add the finished books to your shelves and enjoy! For additional decor get creative; use any odds & ends you can find to give your bookshelf and walls a personal touch. (Ex. buttons, beads, shells, scrap paper/ pictures, open access art via The Met, etc.)
