



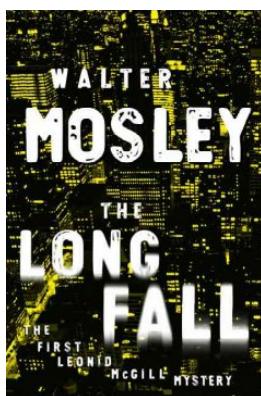

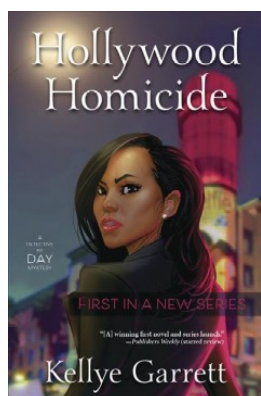

by Walter Mosley

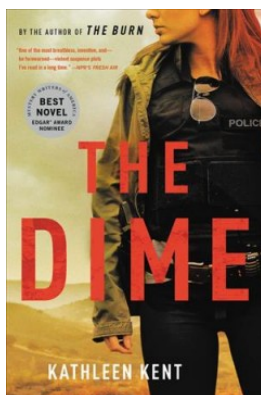

by Kellye Garrett

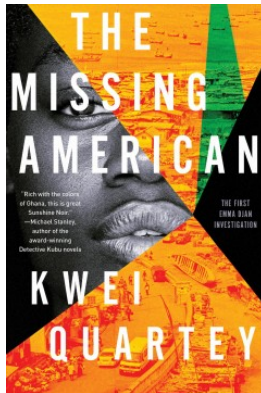

by Kathleen Kent

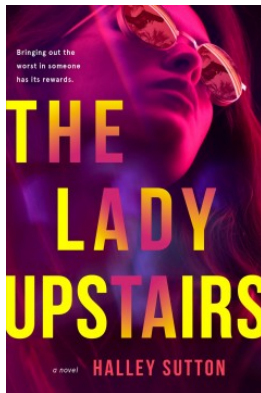

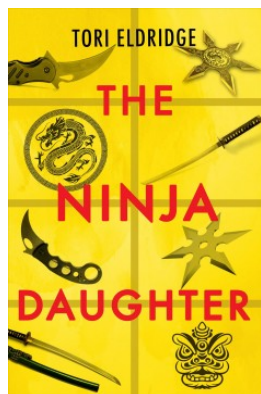

by Halley Sutton

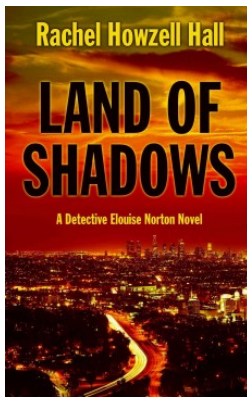

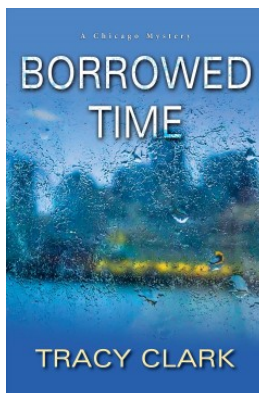


Hide Away

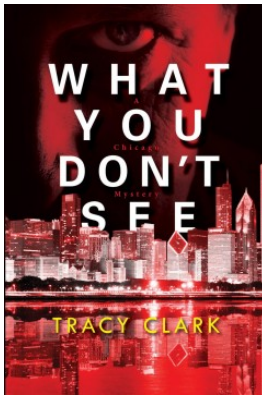

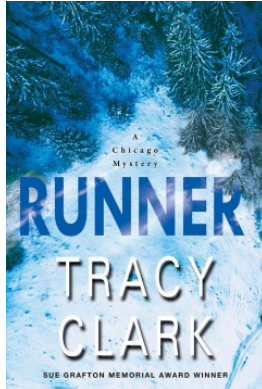
Cassandra Raines, a former Chicago cop turned private investigator, looks into a suspicious death as a favor to a friend—and makes some powerful enemies.
