

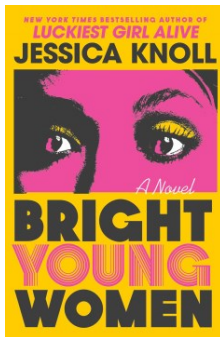

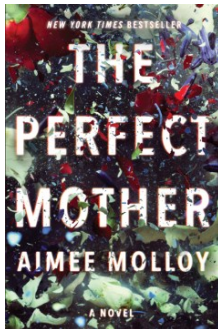

by Jessica Knoll

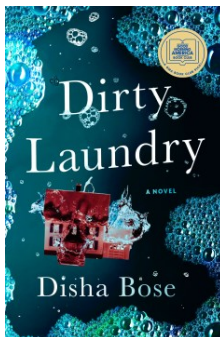

by Aimee Molloy

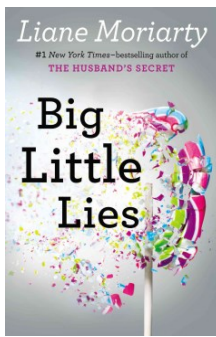

by Liane Moriarty

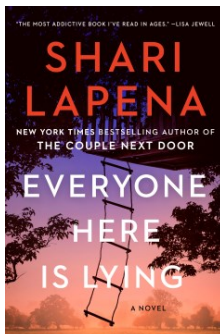

by Tiffany Tsao

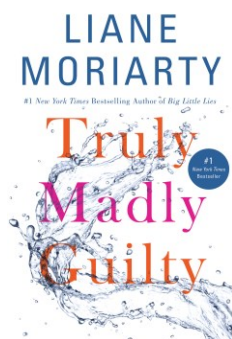

by Shari Lapena

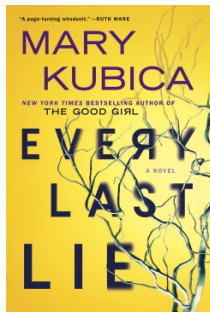

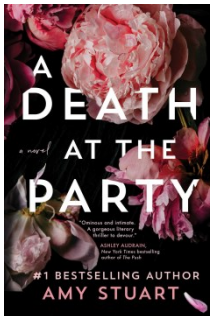
### *Every last lie*

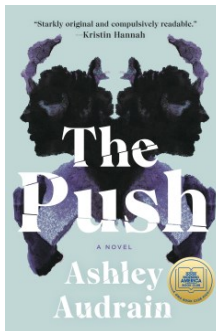
### *A death at the party : a novel*
