

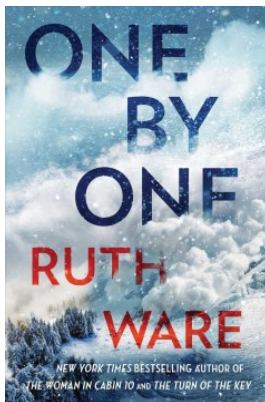

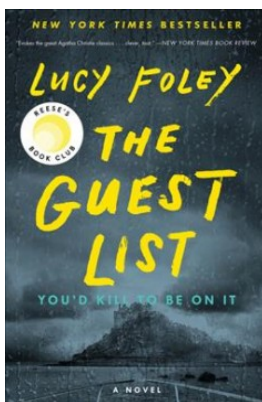

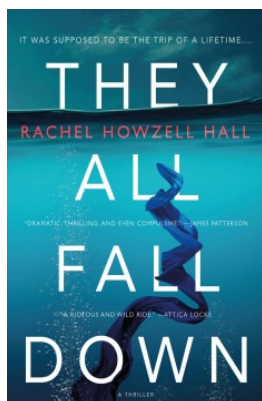

by Lucy Foley

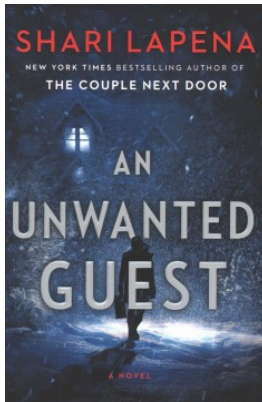

by Rachel Howzell Hall

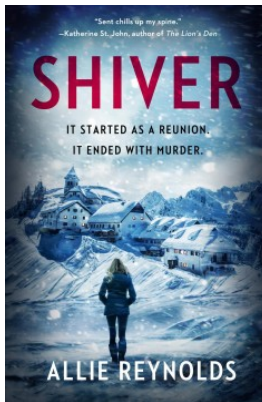

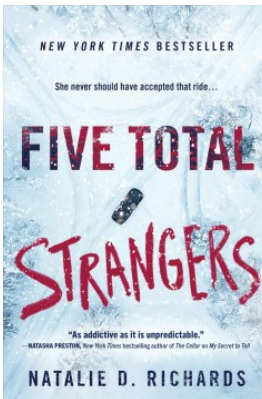
Weathering a storm that has cut them off from the outside world, the guests at a Catskills skiing lodge panic as an unknown assailant starts killing them off one by one.

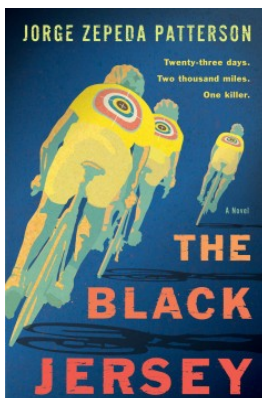

by Natalie D. Richards

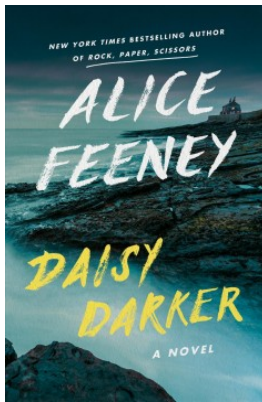
Desperate to reach her grieving mother, Mira joins a group of college students driving home after their flight is stranded, but the road conditions are not the only mortal danger they face

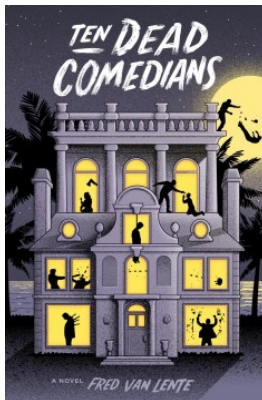

A family gathering for their matriarch's 80th birthday in her crumbling, gothic house on a tiny island begin disappearing one by one.

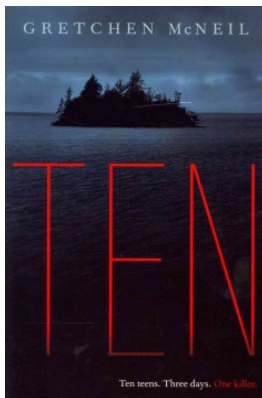

by Fred Van Lente

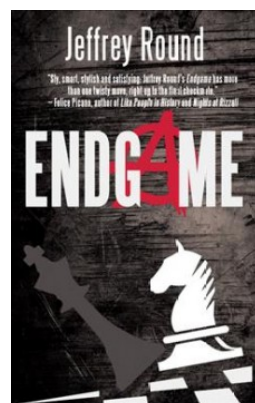

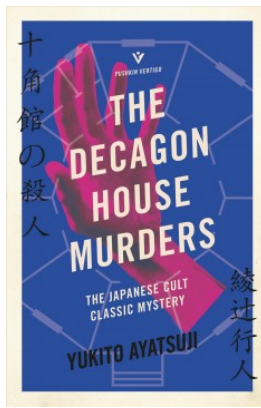

by Jeffrey Round

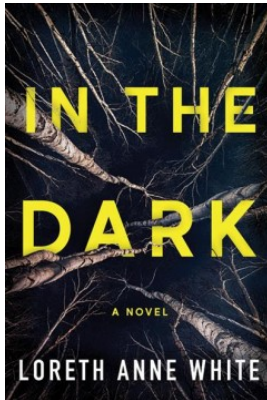

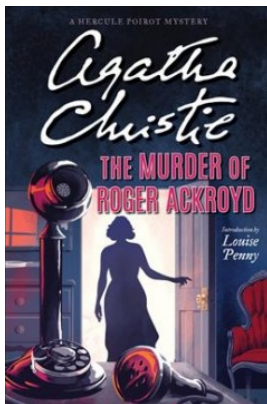


In the Dark

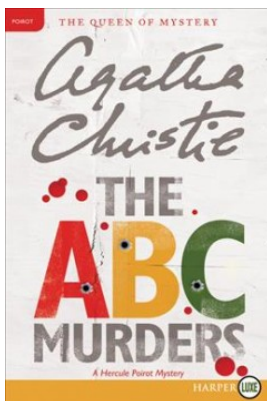

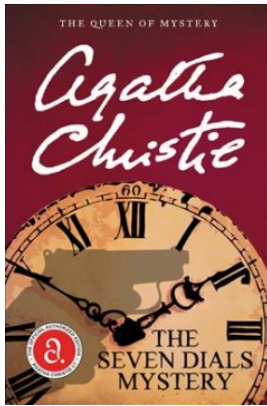

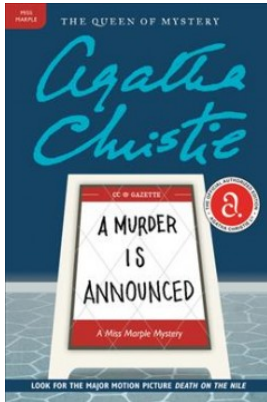
Hercule Poirot's mastery of detective skills is tested by a mysterious correspondent who predicts and then executes alphabetical murders.

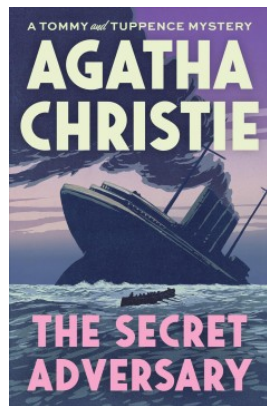
As a practical joke, fellow houseguests put eight alarm clocks under Gerry Wade's bed, only to find a missing clock and a dead man
