

In addition to the excellent selections, each year has an acclaimed horror novelist as the Summer Scares spokesperson, with Clay McCleod Chapman (What Kind of Mother) serving in that capacity for 2024.

We are so excited to not only participate in Summer Scares by providing all kinds of horror-themed content for our patrons, but thanks to the HWA, we will be hosting a virtual panel just for our patrons moderated by Chapman and featuring all three of the authors of the adult selections: Erin E. 




Dr. Grandin's research and understanding of animal behavior spearheaded a reform in the quality of life for agricultural animals worldwide.


