It's so easy to get a library card! All you have to do is bring in proper identification to either library location. Kids can even get their own card! (A parent or guardian may present ID to sign for a child between birth and 15.)

#### So what is proper identification?

The most efficient is a photo ID with your current address, such as a driver's license or state ID. If your photo ID does not have your current address, a second ID with your current address is needed, such as a piece of mail.



UV resin is a quick and easy way to add a glossy protective layer to finished pieces and shrink charms. Simply brush on and allow to cure for a few minutes under the special UV light. Grades 6-12.





September 18 – October 7

This reading challenge celebrates the freedom to read and spotlights current and historical attempts to censor books in libraries and schools. All of the books featured on the accompanying reading list have been targeted for removal or restriction in various libraries.
