The July 17, 2018 meeting of the Friends of the FRVPLD was called to order by President Belindia Elliott at 7:00 pm in the FOL meeting room. **Book Sale** Report: Belindia: Gross sales for the FY June 1, 2017-May 30, 2018 were \$9,401.50. Mini sales did very well. July 14, 2018 sale grossed \$514.30. This was non-fiction only.

Next mini sale will be Saturday, August 11, 9 am – 2 pm; fiction, mystery and large print. Set up Friday at 4:00 pm – need help as library closes at 5:30. Let Belindia know if you will be able to help Friday and/or Saturday. September 8 kid's book sale; 9 am – 2 pm. Since it ends at 2 pm, school district 300 and Sunny Hill school teachers may come in from 2 pm – 3 pm and take remaining books for free. They may bring their own bags. They must show their school district ID tag/card. This will be advertised on various media, emailed to the D300 schools, and also Sunny Hill School (which is in district 220, but serves residents of the FRVPLD). Notice will be emailed to those teachers for whom we have an email address and also put on the school monthly calendar. (See the June minutes for motion to approve).

**Kirstin/library liaison.** Marge Skold will be retiring from the library board at the end of July. A special meeting to honor Marge will be held on July 31. As there will be a vacancy on the Board; someone will be appointed to complete Marge's term; that person will be asked to run for a full term in the April 2019 election.
