

NEW ONLINE CATALOG SYSTEM COMING THIS SPRING

FRVPLD cardholders will be using a new online catalog system this spring to search for titles and place holds. The change was initiated by CCS, the group of libraries that share the catalog and make interlibrary loans possible in our area.





First, materials will be automatically renewed three days before they are due. Patrons will receive a notification letting them know the item(s) have been automatically renewed. The only exclusions are materials that have been requested by another patron and Prize Picks. The system will automatically renew items up to two times (laptops, video games and Playaway Views only renew one time).

Second, patrons can now receive notifications from the library via texts to their cell phones. These notifications include reminders that materials are due or overdue (or were automatically renewed!) or that a hold is ready for pickup.

Third, patrons can now pick up their holds at any CCS library. Currently when you place a hold, you can choose whether you will pick it up at the Dundee Library or the Randall Oaks Library. With the new system, a drop down menu of libraries will appear, and you will click on the library where you would like to pick up your materials.

Patrons who use the reading history feature are encouraged to print out their history as this list will not transfer over. The new system will have this feature, but it will start over and patrons will have to request it again.

DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

I am pleased to invite you to an Open House of "Corner 68," a flexible programming space at the Dundee Library, on Saturday, Feb. 17 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Corner 68, located on the main level of the Dundee Library, is a collaborative learning space for digital and maker-type programs and experiences. Staff led computer classes, book club discussions, language learning sessions, maker and craft programs, and equipment demonstrations will be held here.

With some creative relocating of staff into the acquired space on the lower level (previously occupied by the Dundee Township) we were able to repurpose the workroom located in the southwest corner of the Dundee Library.

This reorganization will result in a more concentrated location for the laptop computers we use for teaching technology classes, and our 3D printer, digital conversion equipment, and sewing machines. When programs are not in session, Corner 68 will be open to the public and staffed by the Information Services department. During these open times, patrons will be able to use the equipment to do everything from convert their wedding video from VHS to DVD to hemming their pants!

We hope you will stop by on Feb. 17 to see the room in action.
