

Friends of the Fox River Valley PLD Minutes. October 15, 2019.

Resolution: The Board of the FRVPLD presented a resolution commending the Friends of the Library for their contributions to the Library. Photos were taken of the FOL members and the Library Board.

Call to Order: The meeting of the FOL was called to order at 7:10 pm by President Linda Ptack. Minutes: Corrections to the time of the Thursday sale to 5:30 – 8:30. And one typo 10:00 am murder mystery party. Diane moved to approve the minutes as corrected, second by Carol; motion carried.

Treasurer's report. Kyle: Balance 9/18/2019 = \$19,530.74. Income \$48.88. no disbursements; bank balance 10/14/2019 = \$19,579.62. Belindia moved to accept the Treasurer's report; second by Carol Prang, motion carried.

Culvers: Due to the way the books are arranged, it is difficult see and reach them. Those who bring the books to the Culvers could suggest a better way to arrange the books so it looks neater. Carol moved to change the cost of the books at Culvers to \$1:00 for all books, second by Mary; motion carried. Kirstin will make new signs and Lisa Blaylock will be informed as she organizes those who take books to Culvers.

Library Liaison, Kirstin: The catalogue system will be down October 19 – 21 as a new library will be added to the system and all data must be installed. Patrons can still check out items, but must have their library card with them. Youth Services has new Sensory Kits for children available to be checked out. There are new toys and books. On Halloween, a 1923 movie for adults will be shown at 7:00 pm.

Book Sale: Help is needed to sort books. It was suggested that each member commit to time on a regular basis to help sort as there are only 3 or 4 who regularly sort. Since we are limited on our inventory, FOL cannot accept magazines, text books and books that are in bad shape or are moldy. It was suggested we use a calendar so sorters can sign up to work; also Belindia can send out an alert if a large donation is received and help is needed to sort.

Book Sale set up and hours: Set up Wednesday, Oct. 16, 3 pm start. Diane will arrange for pizzas and pop; we do not have any volunteers from Kohl's and only one teen helper.

Sale hours: Thursday, Oct. 17, 5:30 – 8:30 pm; Friday, Oct. 18, 9 am – 4 pm; Saturday, Oct. 19, 9 am – 2 pm. Bag sale noon to 2 pm Saturday, \$5 per bag. Clean up after 2 pm closing. Scanners are asked for a \$10 donation. DeLacy teachers may come Saturday to get children's books.

Clearance bag book sale: \$5 per bag, Saturday. November 16, 9 am – 2 pm; set up Friday, Nov. 15 at noon.

Children's Book Sale, Saturday, December 7, 9 am – 2 pm. Set up Friday Dec. 6, 11 am.

Winter Reading program begins December 1 and ends February 1. FOL may possibly donate books for the program. To be discussed later.

The **December FOL** meeting will be held on the second Tuesday, December 10 at 6 pm, a potluck supper party.

Fund Raiser: The store Five Below will donate a portion of sales October 20 – 26 and again November 29 for 1 week. Coupons will be in the newsletter and will be handed out at the book sales.
