### **DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE**

Volunteers are a valuable resource for the Fox River Valley Libraries. Hours spent cleaning DVDs, shelving books, helping with children's programs, cutting bookmarks, cleaning computers, dusting shelves, and folding brochures result in savings for the library while offering individuals a chance to socialize, to learn, and to contribute to their community.

During the first nine months of this fiscal year, volunteers contributed 2,352 hours of service valued at nearly \$33,000 based on what the library would have to pay employees to do similar work.

Our Summer Reading Challenge uses teen volunteers to help children sign up, track their hours, and claim their prizes. The teens gain experience that helps them on college applications and also prepares them for the world of work.

### Sylvia's Story

Sylvia Primorac has been volunteering at the Dundee Library for over two years.

"I am an immigrant. When I initially relocated to the U.S. many years ago, the Internet was at its infancy. My local library was my first port of call.

There I found all the information I needed regarding local government agencies, community based organizations, community colleges, English language instructional programs and other citizenship and immigration resources. I checked out numerous books on US history, geography, politics and social issues. This helped me later on pass my citizenship test.

Now, many years later, I feel it is time to 'give back' not only to my community, but also my 'adopted' country."

### Summer Reading Challenge

### Free Summer Lunch Program

During the school year, many children in our service area receive free or reduced price meals through the National School Lunch Program, but when school is out for the summer nearly 1 in 6 go hungry. For the first time this year, we are partnering with local, state, and national organizations to offer a Free Summer Lunch Program at the Dundee Library (see page 7 for details). Volunteers are the backbone of this program and will be serving healthy, boxed lunches prepared and delivered to the library by the Northern Illinois Food Bank.
