DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE









Summer is always an extra fun and busy time at the Fox River Valley Libraries. Many patrons visit weekly as they participate in the annual Summer Reading Challenge. While the halls of our schools quiet down, the pace picks up at the library as storytimes and programs fill with kids ready to have some fun (without even realizing they are still learning!). The free lunch program that was so successful last year will be served once again starting on Monday, June 4 and we hope to make a lot of new friends like we did last year.

Speaking of friends, we've collaborated with a number of local organizations to bring new experiences and services to the community.

FRVPLD and **Dundee Township Open Space** are teaming up to offer nature programs for teens and adults this summer. The programs, held right behind the Dundee Library in Library Springs, provide a fresh opportunity to apply things you learn in books to real life. Forest bathing, poetry, photography, and danger are just some of the topics to be explored. (*See page 9*)

In June, 70 fifth grade students enrolled in **District 300's** summer school program at Golfview Elementary School will join us in the Corner 68 Maker Lab. They will explore and receive instruction on coding and 3D printing.

FRVPLD's association with the **Dundee Lions Club** goes way back, as their focus on vision and our mission to introduce children to the wonders of reading align so naturally. So when they needed a place to share their cutting edge vision testing technology with the public, we were more than happy to open the doors of the Dundee Library to them. On Thursday, June 28, the Lions will provide free vision prescreening tests for children ages six months to 10 years.

Their new PlusoptiX Screener works just like a camera and looks for nearsightedness, farsightedness, and astigmatism. The test takes just seconds, but can be an important tool to identify eye conditions that interfere with learning if left unaddressed. The Lions will provide information on resources for families who need to follow up on their test results. (See page 3)

To wrap up the summer with a splash, we are co-hosting the first-ever Summer Reading Challenge Finisher's Party with the **Dundee Township Park District**. Anyone who finishes the reading program this summer will receive a ticket to the party at Dolphin Cove Family Aquatic Center on Sunday, August 6 from 6 to 8 p.m. There will be lots of fun and prizes to celebrate and reward our readers.

Collaboration with organizations and individuals within our community lets us reach more residents, whether they come to the library or we go to them. I'm looking forward to announcing more partnerships and resources for our patrons, with a focus on local business, this fall.
