THE BENEFITS OF SUMMER READING ARE CLEAR

Summer is definitely "high season" at the library as summer reading seems to inspire readers of all ages to grab an inviting book and kick back in the shade for some well-deserved relaxation. For students and adults who read a lot for school or work, reading can sometimes feel like a chore. Summer reading encourages us to read for pleasure as well. Consider these benefits from the Illinois Library Association:

- National research from Dominican University finds that students
 who participate in public library summer reading programs scored
 higher on reading achievement tests at the beginning of the next
 school year than those who did not participate.
- Parents of children enrolled in the public library summer reading program reported that their children spent more time reading over the summer, read more books, were well prepared for school in the fall, and read more confidently.
- Young people experience learning losses when they don't engage in educational activities during the summer. Research spanning 100 years shows that students typically score lower on standardized tests at the end of summer vacation than they do on the same tests at the beginning of the summer. Libraries are part of the solution.
- There's so much to see, so much to do at your library! There's no better place to take your kids. The library is a place to learn, read, and have fun...a place the whole family can enjoy.
- Studies show that children who are read to in the home and who use the library perform better in school and are more likely to continue to use the library as a source of lifetime learning.

This year our summer reading challenge theme is "A Universe of Stories." We invite the entire community to sign up, read, and participate in the many special programs we have planned.






