- Once you have placed your item(s) on hold, select "Fox River Valley

 item on hold is ready, you will receive a notice, via your preferred
 notification method, that your item will be delivered.

Free cable gun locks available at the Dundee Library

Responsible and secure gun storage can help to prevent suicides and accidents resulting from guns. Gun locks can help to keep a gun stored securely and discourage unauthorized persons (such as children, guests, contractors, and uninvited people) from accessing the gun.

Free cable gun locks can be picked up from the Greeter Desk at the Dundee Library. The locks are provided as part of the "Together for a Safer Illinois" program, supported by the U.S Department of Veterans Affairs, Kane County Health Department, and Illinois Department of Public Health.





This online resource can be found at www.frvpld.info/database-information. The SAT prep tools are located in the SkillSurfer section under "College Entrance Test Prep." Here you will find:

- **Prep Pack.** Visit this first. It has "what to expect" tips and test-taking strategies like "Finding the Main Idea" on the Reading test and "The Best Ways to Approach Multiple Choice Questions" on the Math test.
- Mathematics. Dig deep into practice quizzes, sample questions, and refreshers on numbers and operations, algebra and functions, statistics, probability, geometry, and measurement.
- **Writing & Language.** Practice tests and tutorials on topics like improving sentences and using parallelism.
- Reading. Leave plenty of time to cover passage-based reading lessons and vocabulary flash cards.
- **Practice Tests.** Time to give it a go! Take as many as you like as many times as you like.

Need a library card? If you are 15 or older, you can show a valid student ID as a form of identification, along with proof of your home address. If you've never had a card, you can get a digital card that is valid immediately and good for one month (then come into the library to get your permanent card). It can be used to access Brainfuse. 
