CONDUCTED ABRAHAM LINCOLN SAFELY  
THROUGH THE RANKS OF TREASON TO THE SCENE  
OF HIS FIRST INAUGURATION AS PRESIDENT.

DEFENDED THE SLAVES, AND LABORED  
EARNESTLY FOR THEIR FREEDOM.
